# **Technology Use & Opt-Out option**

### Dear Parent/Guardian:

### If you wish to Opt-Out:

Parents or guardians have the right to terminate their student's access to electronic tools and resources, and/or the restriction of the use of photos and schoolwork on websites, by completing the Computer Technology Opt-Out Form and delivering it to the school registrar. The Computer Technology Opt-Out Form may be found on the BUUSD website or https://tinyurl.com/TechOptOut

The Opt-Out Form will remain in effect for one school year and expires at the end of this school year. A parent or guardian must complete a new Opt-Out Form each school year. If no documentation is on file, it will be assumed that permission has been granted for access to school computers, the Internet, Google Core Services, Google Add-on Services, and other electronic educational resources.
